



Results

Results are produced live throughout the race. You can find them on the DURT website by using the QR code which is printed on the race plates, and it is also available on notices around the event village.

Your race plate contains your timing chips.

- Do not have more than 1 plate on your bike.
- Do not bring your bike to the timing tent if you have a question.

There will also be 2 types of live results displayed on TVs.

- There is one TV about 20 metres after the finish line. This is positioned for the riders who are finishing a lap so they can see their lap time. For the 10 most-recent riders to cross the line it shows the rider's number, name, team name, school, lap time and what number lap it is for the team. In the top-right is a race-time clock for the event. Spectators should obstruct the riders' view of this TV.
- In the admin tent, there will be 2 TVs.
 - One is a repeat of the lap times TV for the riders mentioned above.
 - The other shows results for the race and is split up into the three overall categories of Junior, Intermediate and Senior. It cycles through, displaying 25 teams per screen, with each screen remaining visible for about 15 seconds before it goes on to the next screen. The information shown, from left to right on the screen is:
 - Overall Place
 - How many laps the team has done
 - Total race time for the team
 - Team Name and School
 - Number, Name and Lap Time of the last rider from the team
 - The Team's Race Category and their place in that category

If you have a question about the results, the supervising Teacher/Parent can ask at the Orange timing tent near the finish line.

Riders must not bring their bikes, with plates attached, near this tent.
