



2024 WEMBO World Solo 24 Hour Mountain Bike Championships

Category Mapping

WEMBO World Championships to Australian Championships

There is only one race – the WEMBO 2024 World Solo 24 Hour Mountain Bike Championships and all Solo riders enter this race. However, an additional set of results, for Australian riders only, will be produced at the end of the race and this will be used by AusCycling to award the Australian Solo 24 Hour Champions for 2024.

The categories used by AusCycling are not identical to the WEMBO categories, so the categories in which people enter for WEMBO will be mapped to the Australian categories as follows, for male and female:

Australian Riders in these WEMBO Categories will be placed in these Australian Solo 24 Hr Championship categories at the end of the race to determine their placings in the Australian Championships
Elite (open to riders 18 and over)	Elite
Single Speed	Expert
Under 23	Expert
23-29	Expert
30-34	Masters 1_2
35-39	Masters 1_2
40-44	Masters 3_4
45-49	Masters 3_4
50-54	Masters 5_6
55-59	Masters 5_6
60-64	Masters 7+
65-69	Masters 7+
70+	Masters 7+
Riders with a Disability	Adaptive Group 1A

Notes: There are no e-bike categories in WEMBO, so there will be no e-bike category results produced for Australian riders.

WEMBO riders in Single Speed, U23 and 23-29 will be placed in Australian “Expert” by default. They can choose to be placed in Australian “Elite” (or an Australian Masters category if they are over 30) if they wish but this choice must be advised by the rider at registration and it cannot be altered after 1000 on Saturday 28 September 2024.
